Community Announcement

Have you ever worried that something might happen to you and because you live alone, no one would know? A member has recently recommended a free app that could help you feel more secure in your independence. The app is called Snug. Once you download it to your phone, you set up the parameters for it to work for you. First you pick a time during the day by which it would be convenient for you to "check in" by tapping the button on the app page. Then you set up the contacts that you'd like to be notified if you don't check in. If you haven't checked in by your selected time, you will get a text prompt to do so. Ten minutes later, you'll get another. If 25 minutes after your selected time you still haven't checked in, the app will send a text to those you chose that they might want to check up on you. And if you finally check in, those people receive a notice that all's okay. This app can give peace of mind to those who live alone as well as friends and family members who are at a distance.
