

First Presbyterian Church Tallahassee
Called Meeting of Congregation – Sunday, September 29, 2024
Close of Worship: 11:50am

By previous session action a meeting of the congregation was called for Sunday, September 29, 2024 for the purpose of electing a church nominating committee.

The meeting was called to order by the moderator, Rev. Glenn Hodges and opened with prayer. Chris Corzine, Clerk of Session, confirmed a quorum was present including members in person in the sanctuary along with several members attending via Zoom meeting.

The moderator confirmed the purpose of the meeting was for the election of a nominating committee for First Presbyterian Church of Tallahassee. The moderator shared the requirements of a nominating committee from G-2.0401 of the PC(USA) Book of Order, which includes the following:

The rule shall meet the following criteria:

- (1) the minimum size of the committee as specified in the rule shall be at least three persons;
- (2) at least one member of the committee shall be an elder currently serving on session; and
- (3) a majority of those persons on the committee who are eligible to vote shall consist of persons not currently serving on session.

The Clerk announced the existing slate of nominations for the nominating committee:

- Peggy West
- Peggy Wright-Cleveland
- Carol Weissert
- Aide Whitaker

The Clerk announced that an additional nomination from the floor was needed to complete the requirements of the committee.

The moderator opened the floor to nominations. A nomination for Donnie Watts was heard, she confirmed a willingness to serve, her nomination was seconded. No other nominations from the floor were heard.

The clerk presented: Peggy West, Peggy Wright-Cleveland, Carol Weissert, Aide Whitaker and Donnie Watts

The moderator opened the floor to discussion. No discussion was heard. A motion was heard and seconded that a vote be called. The moderator called the question, and the slate was elected by the body without any objection.

The congregational meeting was closed in a charging prayer by the moderator.
